What does your Eden look like?
Definition of Eden- Paradise
Definition of Paradise- an ideal place or state
Definition of Ideal- Satisfying one's conception of what is perfect or most suitable
In other words, everything that God created in the beginning was Eden to God. It was exactly as it was conceived in the mind of God. In the book of Genesis, as it is written, everything God created was GOOD, until it was no longer good.

Describes and affined above to be the ideal in acceptant. The consideration is from ideal, the in-the contract to the contract to the ideal and in-the ideal and ideal

Remember, as defined above, what is ideal is conceived. The word ideal originates from idea which is a thought or suggestion or it could mean the aim or purpose of something.

Just maybe the garden of Eden was tainted by the knowledge of good and evil, which is the Tree that God told Adam NOT to eat from. Maybe, the knowing of evil, turns into perception, which will then bring in to light (conception) that "thing(s)." Something like your thoughts (what is hidden) coming into fruition (that which you can see).
